Letters of Endorsement and Letters of Reference Information

Per the Volunteer Services Policy, each Level I and Level II volunteer is required to have EITHER a Letter of Endorsement OR two Letters of Reference. This is a requirement for volunteering or attending events on a memo, one to four times a year (Level I); or entering more than four times a year with a badge (Level II). If you are representing an agency, a letter of endorsement is required. If you are not here representing an agency, two letters of reference are required.

Letter of Endorsement:

- Must be written on the organization's letterhead by the endorser.
- Must have the original signature of the endorser.
- Must state how long and in what capacity the endorser has known the volunteer.
- Must attest to the volunteer's ability to perform the duties requested and how the endorser knows this information.
- Any other information the endorser would like to share regarding the volunteer.

Letter of Reference:

- Two letters of reference from non-family members whom the volunteer has known longer than six months.
- The letters must include how they know the volunteer and how they can attest to the volunteer's skills, credibility, and integrity.
- The letters must include the writer's contact information.

Letters of Endorsement and Letters of Reference must be renewed every 5 years.
